A seat must be reserved for everyone in your group and your reservation total must reflect all students, chaperones and teachers attending. All tickets must be reserved through the school group. Parents are not permitted to purchase tickets on their own. Send your order as soon as possible to avoid being placed on a waiting list.

STEP 3

Return the confirmation to LTCA within one week. Send your payment to the LTCA by the payment due date. This will be four weeks prior to the performance. Reservations not paid by the due date may be canceled in order to accommodate groups on waiting lists.

STEP 4

On the day of performance, please arrive 20 minutes before curtain time. Remind students that gum, food and beverages are not allowed in the Tack Center House or Gallery. An usher will meet your group in the Gallery and escort you to your seats. Youngest children are seated in the front rows so that their sightline to the stage is unimpeded.
