BACKSTAGE and TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

All Backstage and Technical LTCA Volunteers report to the Technical Director, or his representative. Volunteers in these capacities should be 18 years of age, or older, and able to follow detailed directions. Being comfortable with heights is a plus. Those assisting with LOAD IN/OUT should be able to safely lift heavy objects with help. General tasks include:

- FOCUSING LIGHTS
- REPAIRING and PAINTING STAGE FLOOR
- LIGHTBOARD OPERATION: experience required
- SOUNDBOARD OPERATION: experience required
- LOAD IN/SET-UP/STRIKE/LOAD OUT CREW: arrive at appointed load-in time; be capable of safely lifting heavy objects with assistance; unload performer's equipment; set up per stage plot as directed by technical director/stage manager; strike set-up following performance; load-out performer's equipment; return LTCA equipment to proper storage space.

Some backstage/technical opportunities are ongoing throughout the season (lighting, stagecraft) and help is usually needed evenings and/or weekends. Others are show specific (load in/set-up/load out.) Time commitment varies with task, but is flexible.
